Event: 5 Tree Plantation on 24.09.2024



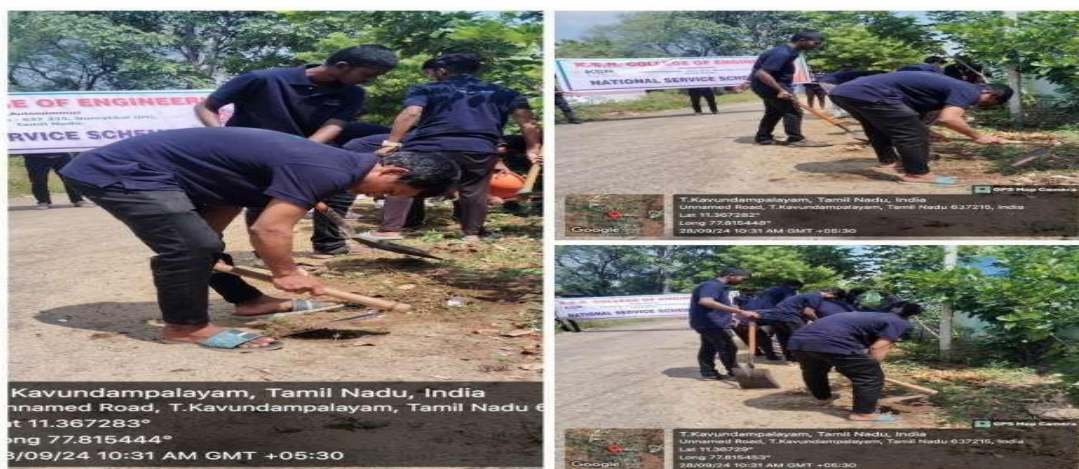

Event:9 Voter's Awareness Program on 26.10.2024

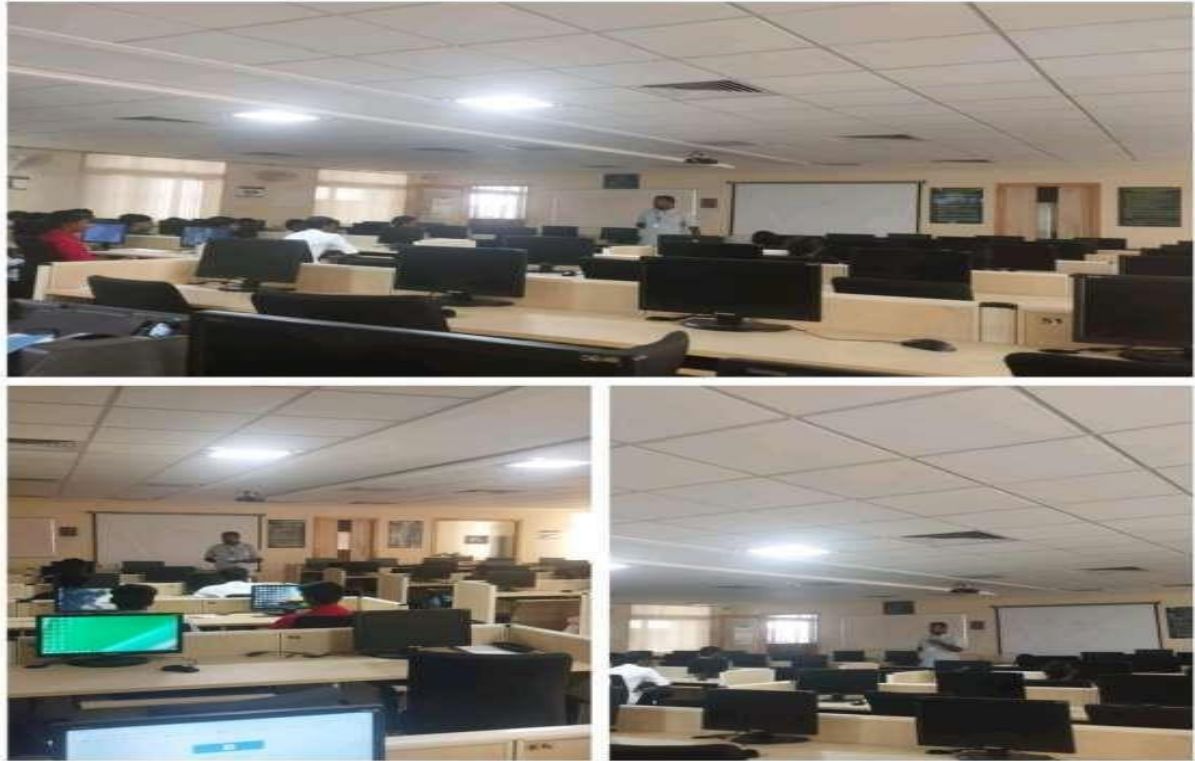
