



Date: 28.09.2024 Time: 1.30 pm Venue: Library 2st Floor (Bharathidasan Library)



Date: 26.10.2024 Time: 1.30 pm Venue: Smart Board Hall Library 3st Floor (Rharathidasan Library







Date: 08.02.2025 Time: 1.30 pm Venue: Smart Board Hall Library 3st Floor (Bharathidasan Library)


