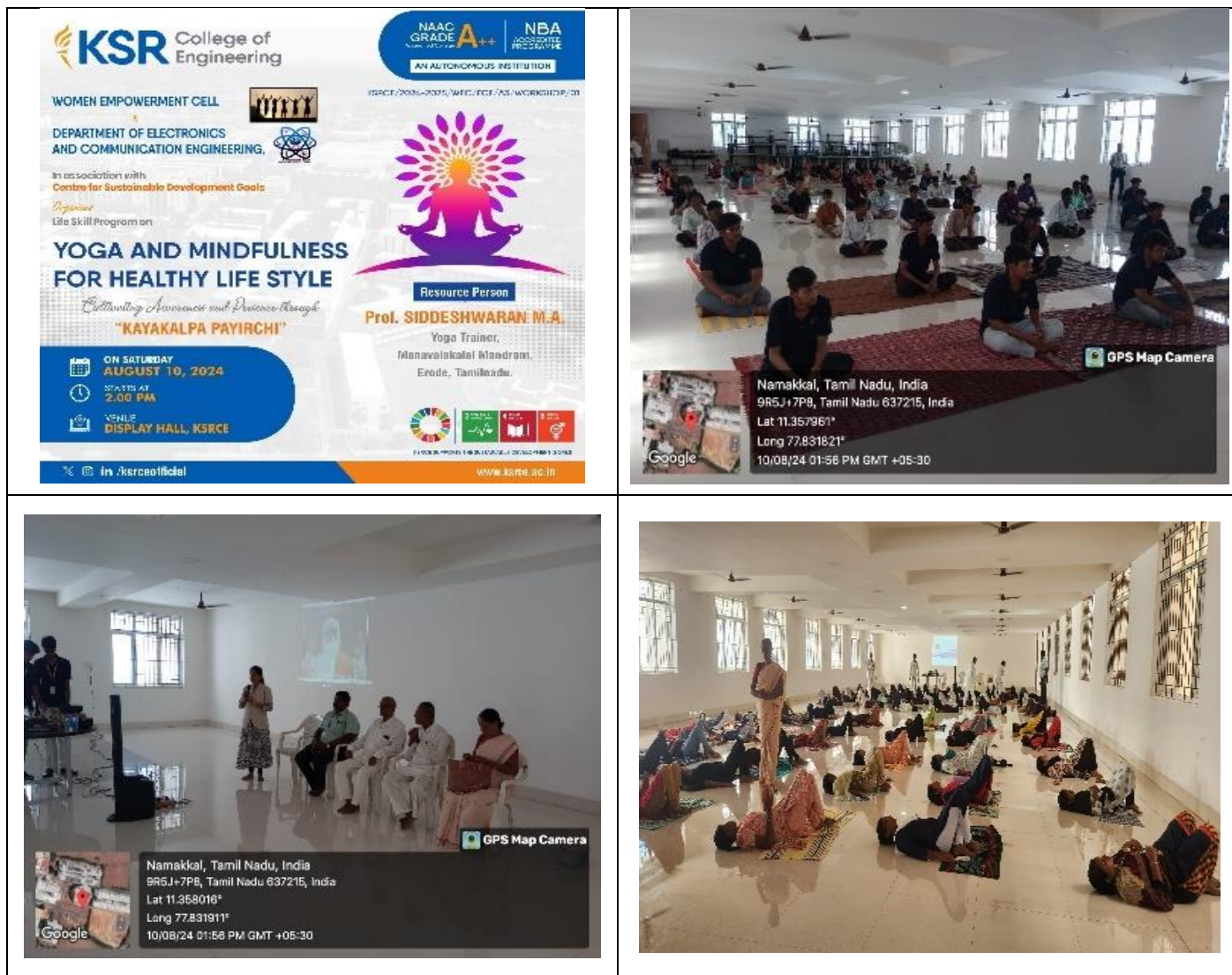

## Event 1: Workshop on "Yoga and Mindfulness for Healthy Life Style" on 10-08-2024

### Event 3: Seminar on Ensuring Electrical Safety in High Voltage Systems: Mitigating Risks for Sustainable Energy Production and Consumption on 18.10.2024

The Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering, in collaboration with the SDG Cell, organized a seminar on 18th October 2024 focusing on **ELECTRICAL SAFETY IN HIGH-VOLTAGE SYSTEMS AND ITS ROLE IN SUSTAINABLE ENERGY**. Expert speakers Mr. R. Sivaram and Mr. A. Gokul Raaju covered key topics such as risk assessment, insulation techniques, grounding systems, fault handling, and safety protocols. The session emphasized the importance of technical safety, adherence to standards, and sustainable practices. Interactive discussions engaged students and faculty, providing practical insights. The seminar concluded with encouraging feedback, highlighting its effectiveness in promoting awareness of safe and sustainable energy systems.





#### Event 4: Mushroom Cultivation for Woman on 19.10.2024

A workshop on mushroom cultivation for women was successfully held by the Department of Management Studies (MBA) in collaboration with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Cell. The workshop's objectives were to support sustainable livelihood practices and women's rights. SDGs 5 (Gender Equality), 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), and 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production) were all in line with the initiative.

A variety of mushroom cultivation topics, such as substrate preparation, spawning, harvesting, and fundamental marketing strategies, were covered in the training. The workshop focused on the nutritional and economic benefits of mushrooms as a viable home-based business venture. Many women were encouraged to think about small-scale cultivation by the program's positive reception. It successfully improved self-reliance, entrepreneurial abilities, and environmental awareness – making a significant grassroots contribution to inclusive, sustainable development.

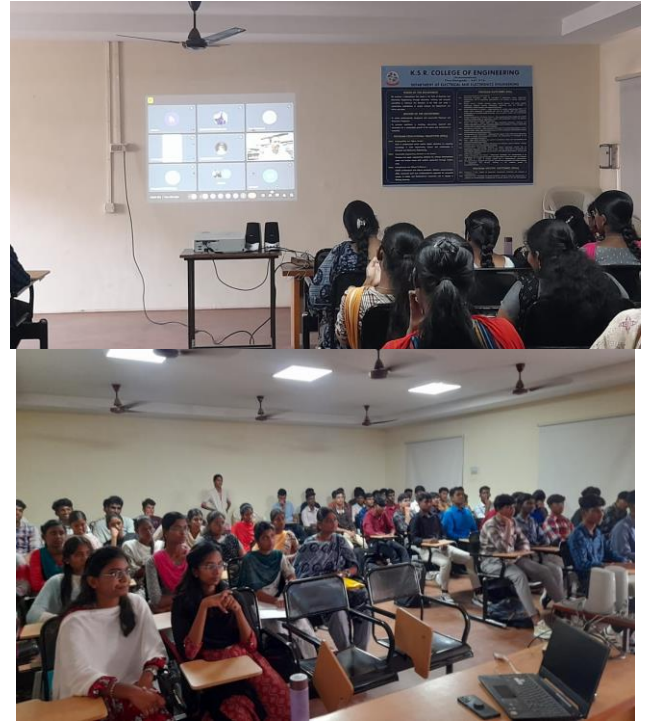


## Event 5: சங்ககால கடல்சார் தொல்லியல் அகழாய்வுகள் on 21.10.2024

The Department of Biomedical Engineering, in collaboration with the SDG Cell, organized a field trip on 26th October 2024 focusing **ON LAKE CLEANUP AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY**. The program's goal was to raise students' awareness of the value of protecting the environment and restoring water bodies.
