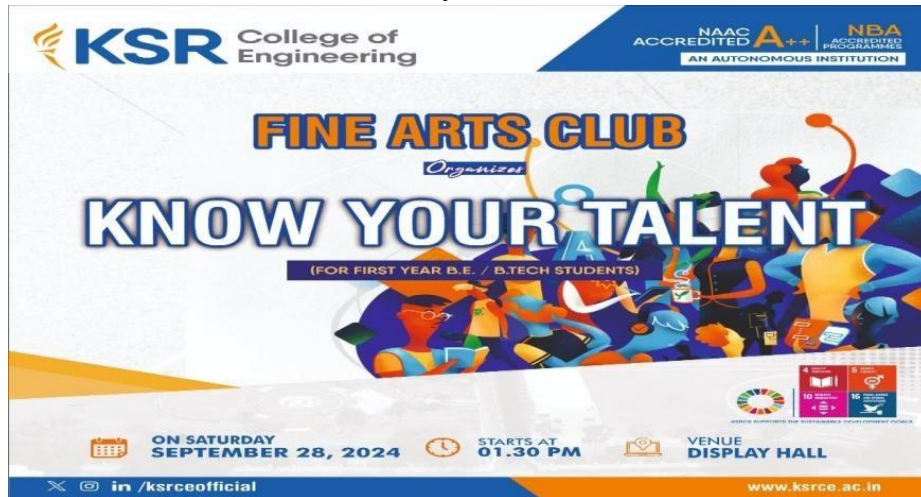
EVENT 1: KNOW YOUR TALENT

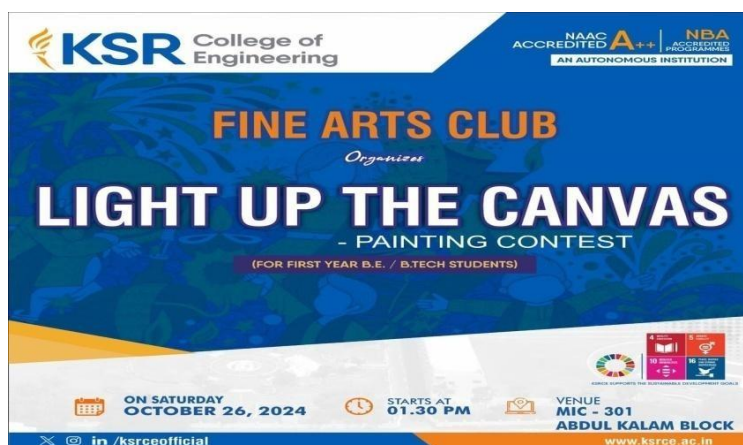
EVENT 2: PAINTING CONTEST - LIGHT UP THE CANVAS

The club students were asked to perform the Painting Contest on Diwali in view of the 'Diwali Celebrations - Light Up the Canvas'



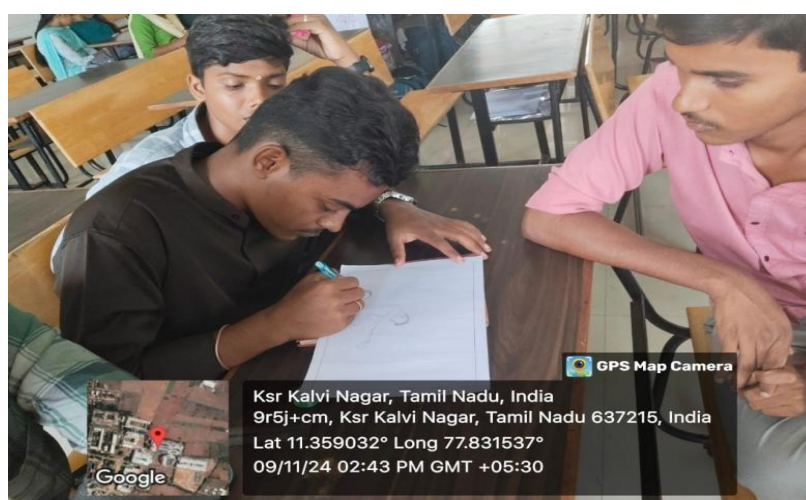
EVENT 3: PAINTING CONTEST - PENCIL SKETCH on SAY NO TO DRUGS

Students were informed to participate on the Debate on the topic of Deforestation and Plantation in view of Afforestation week.



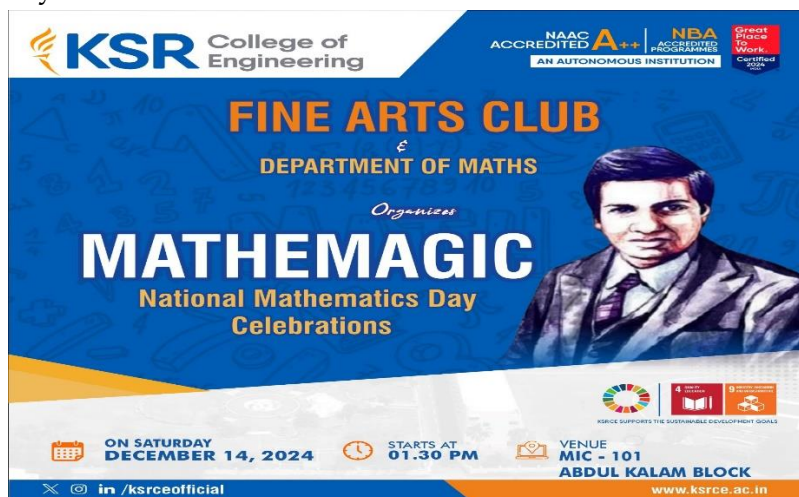
EVENT 5: DRAWING CONTEST - PENCIL SKETCH
